

**What is a tax credit?**

A tax credit is a NOT a donation! It is a direct, dollar for dollar reduction in the state income tax you pay. When filing your income tax return for the State of Arizona, the amount you designate to the Creighton School District (CSD) will be the amount you may claim as a state tax credit.

- * This payment is eligible for Arizona State income tax credit as allowed by ARS 43-1089.01.
- * Tax credit contributions are non-refundable.
- * Contributions received from January 1, 2019 thru April 15, 2020 can be claimed on your Arizona State 2019 tax return.

How much can I contribute?

Any amount up to the maximum allowable for 2019:

Single or Head of Household: \$200 Married Filing Jointly: \$400 Married Filing Separately: \$200

Where does my contribution go?

Contributions directly fund PASS life skills programs, snacks, tennis equipment, and field trips in the CSD.

What do I need to do to participate?

1. FILL OUT this form so we may properly process and track your payment.
2. MAIL this form with your personal check (no business accounts) or completed credit card information.

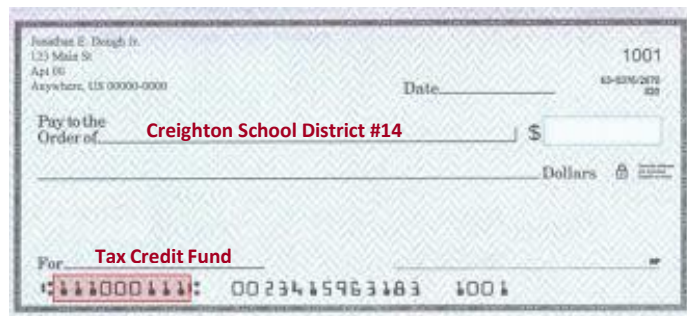
